


# PBL Presentation Day

February 5, 2020



Then rather than sign up for a time slot, when one student's Rube Goldberg Machine is working and ready for an audience, we will move together to watch the action. Audience members must be 4th graders or older due to the many moving parts in these contraptions.

Middle School students will also explain their "goals, doors, and barriers" before showcasing their Rube Goldberg Machines.

This project has given our students opportunities to think about their own goals while working on STEM engineering skills. Additionally, they are writing about the 1920s, when Rube Goldberg's artwork was featured in newspapers around the country:
